

10 DAYS INTO KREMLIN'S INFORMATION WAR



FEBRUARY 25

Roskomnadzor has ramped up censorship efforts: Russia's media regulator has banned the use of the words "war", "attack" and "invasion"

MARCH 1

Écho Moskvý's transmissions suspended. The radio transmits also in the US and in Chicago. Same destiny for Dozhd TV

MARCH 2

- EU closes 2 major Russian TV channels in Europe: Russia Today and Sputnik
- European Commission is developing tools to ban disinformation in Europe



MARCH 3

All independent broadcasters in Russia in the radio and television market face regulatory pressure: TV Rain has announced that it will cease operations indefinitely

MARCH 4

New law against "spreading disinformation about the armed forces of the Russian Federation in any military conflicts", punishable by up to 15 years in prison: the law has been adopted by the Duma

MARCH 5

Major Italian channels Mediaset and Rai decided to call back their reporters



MARCH 6

Apple, Samsung, Microsoft, Oracle, Cisco and others have pulled back or withdrawn entirely from Russia

MARCH 7

The Duma finalized their exclusion of social media in the country:
Facebook, Youtube, Tiktok

MARCH 8

Ultra-nationalists started writing a "Z" on tanks or cars to show their support to the war

MARCH 9

The Duma affirmed that is organizing black lists of journalists (also retractive effect) in the world that wrote against the government
